- The Old Testament reveals Christ, Christianity, salvation, and the church.





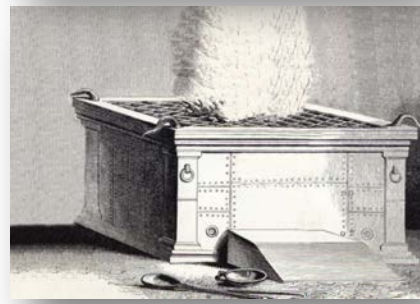
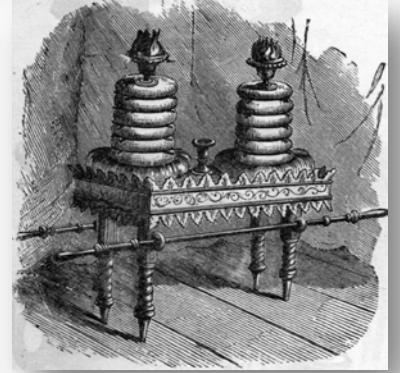

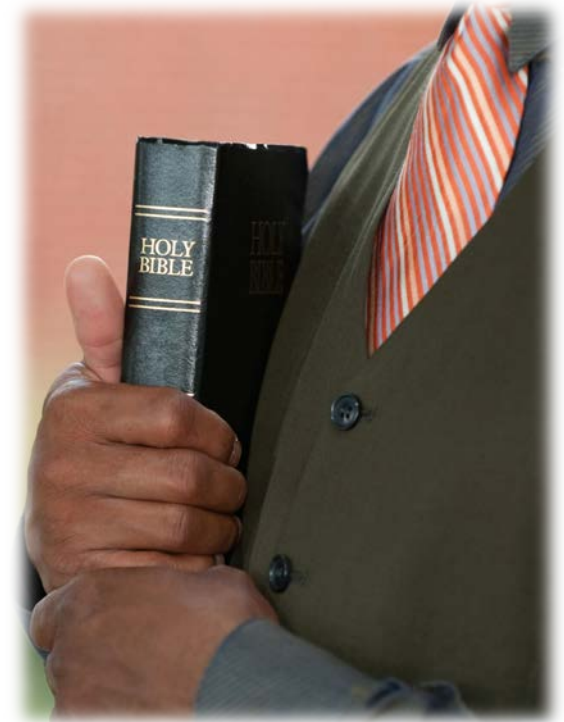
GOD DESIRES TO TABERNACLE (DWELL WITH) HIS PEOPLE



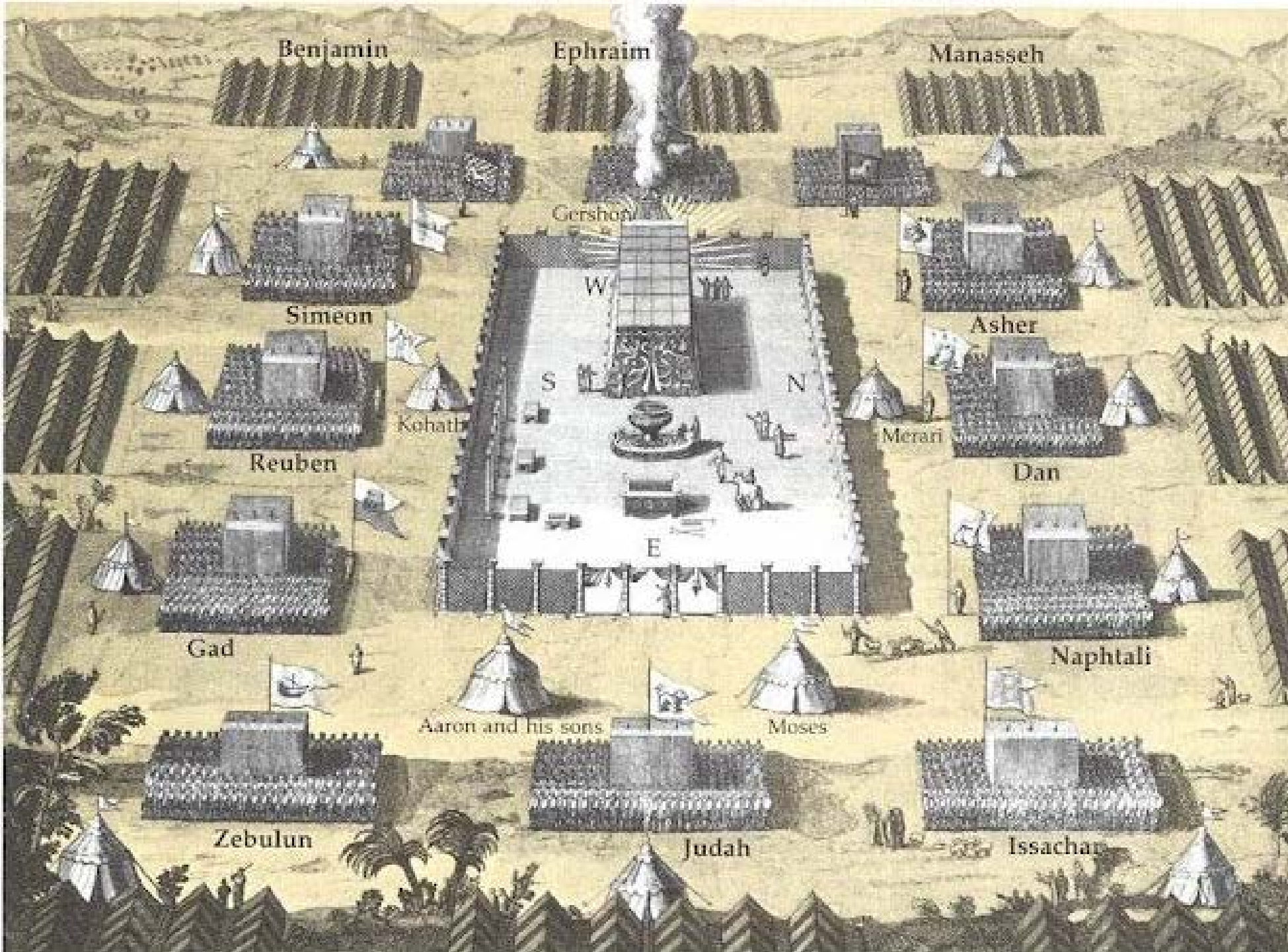
"Make me [God] a sanctuary;

(Exodus 25:8).



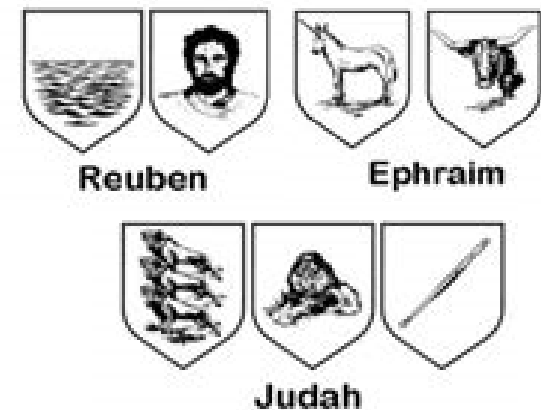
"And the Word (Christ) became

(Revelation 21:3).

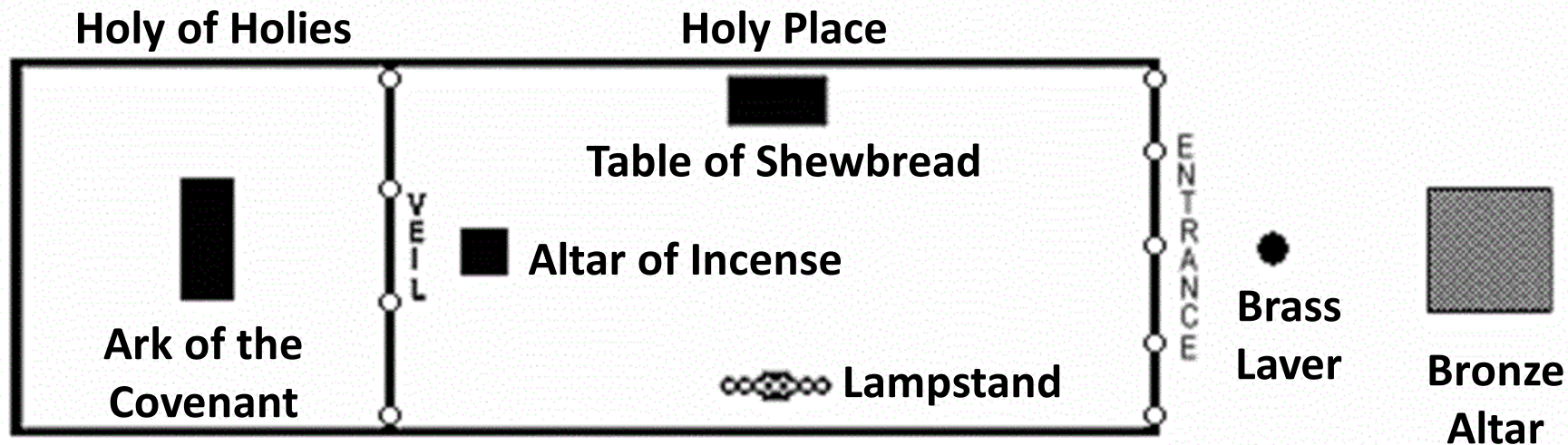

THE HOLY PLACE
THE HOLY OF HOLIES
