- The Tabernacle was called "Tent of Meeting."
- 50 Chapters in the Bible tell of the Tabernacle, its furnishings, and its practices.
- The Tabernacle was a visual explanation to help us understand God's plan of salvation.
- Tabernacle's cost (in today's value) would have been more than \$1.5 million dollars.
- The Tabernacle furnishings were in the shape of a cross (a shadow of what was to come).
- The Tabernacle faced east (source of light).
- All the tents faced the Tabernacle.
- Our body is a tabernacle (dwelling place).

The word "Tabernacle" in Hebrew is *Shakhan*, which means "to dwell."

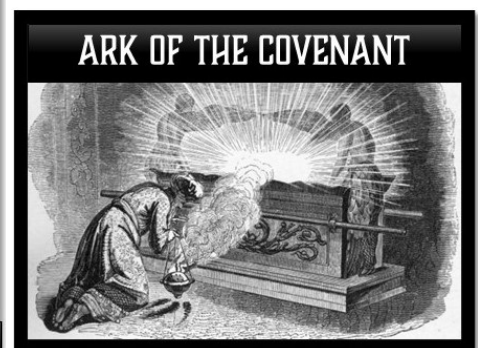
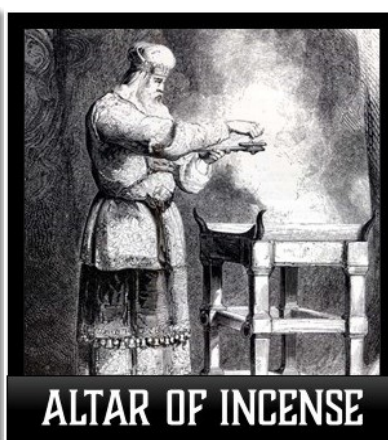
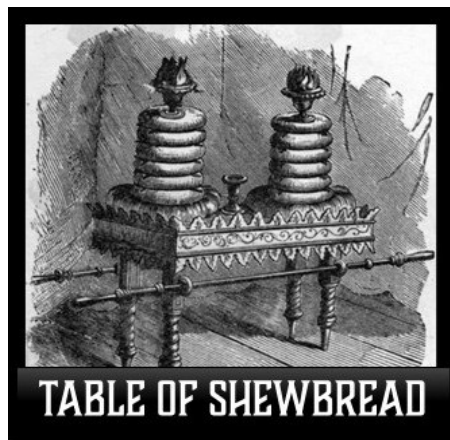
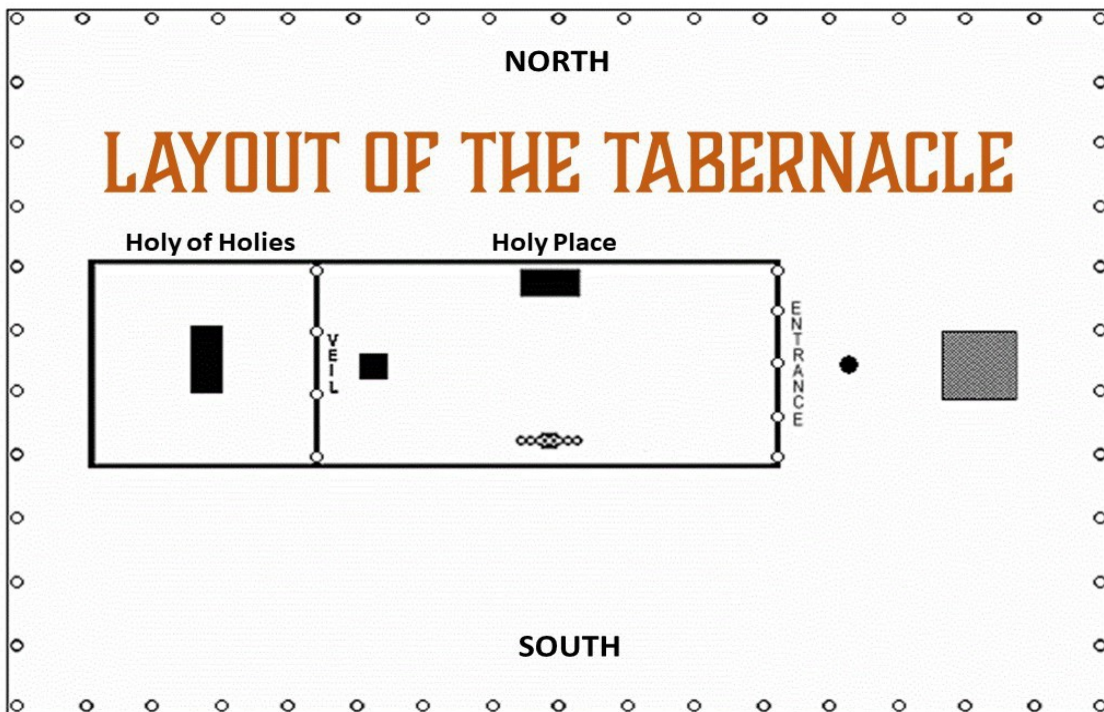
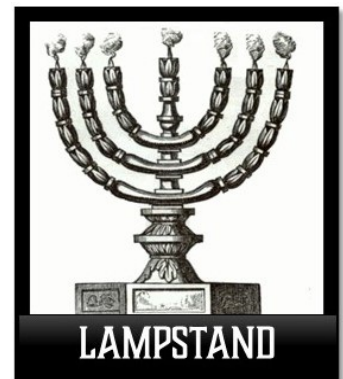
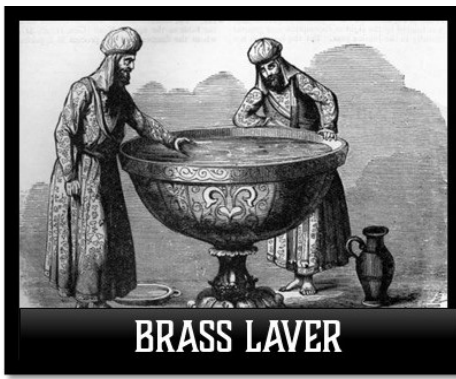
